Cross-country Skiing **A Winter Outing of the Environmental Concerns Hiking Series**

Enjoy a mid-winter's night at NEOEA's annual cross-country ski outing at Lake Metroparks' Chapin Forest Reservation. Explore several miles of lighted and groomed trails on Saturday, January 25. We'll start the evening with a cross-country skiing lesson and guided ski tour from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. You may continue to ski on your own until 7:30 p.m. Meet at the heated Chapin Forest Pine Lodge at 5:30 p.m. to check-in and prepare to ski.

Fees:

Ski lesson and tour (6:00 to 7:00)	\$4.00 (includes skis, if you need them)
Ski rental for additional ski time (7:00 to 7:30)	\$2.00

Advanced reservation is required.

Directions to the Chapin Forest Hobart Road Entrance: Take I-90 to Route 306. Travel south on Route 306 for 3-1/2 miles to Chardon Road (Route 6). Turn right (west) onto Route 6 (Chardon Road) and travel one mile to Hobart Road. Turn right (north) onto Hobart Road for almost 1/2 mile to the park entrance located on the right (east) side of the road. **Please note:** You will pass a Chapin Forest entrance and sign on Route 306. **Do not enter at this site**, as it does not access Pine Lodge.
