NEA's Minority Leadership Training Conference will take place on Wednesday through Friday, February 19-21, 2014, at a location to be determined. NEOEA will make available five scholarships for NEOEA members to attend the conference, which is followed by the annual East Summit on February 21-23, 2014.

To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must apply to NEOEA by Friday, December 6, 2013, using the form on the back of this flyer. Recipients are expected to share a report on their conference experiences with both this NEOEA Minority Organizing Committee on April 23, 2014, and with your local district.

Winners will be responsible for making their own registration, room, and travel arrangements. Recipients will receive a letter detailing instructions for registering for both the Minority Leadership Training Conference and the East Summit. Attendance at both is mandatory.
